


Make sure the projector is turned on.

If the green light is on, the projector is on.

If the green light is not on, you will need to turn it on.

If it is on and you see the green light, and not projecting anything, you may need to "un-mute" it or do a source search.




Projector Remote

To turn the projector on:

1. Point remote at projector
2. Press the Red Power Button on the remote.

To "un-mute" the projector:


1. Take the remote and point it at the projector
2. Press the A/V Mute button, this will "un-mute" or "mute" the projector (Muting it is not turning it off, it just enables display)



To do a source search:

1. On the remote press the source search button(see picture of remote to locate the source search button, it is circled)


2. This screen will project, make sure the projector highlights Computer



Once the projector is on and working, make sure the document camera is on.

If the green light on the document camera is on then it is on.

If green light is not lit up, turn the document camera on by pressing the gray button locate on the side of the camera



To project from the document camera make sure the Camera button is lit up.

If the Camera button is not lit up, hold it down

Sound:

This is the sound cord.

It needs to be plugged into your device (computer, iPad, iPhone)

Plug it in where you would plug in headphones

Once this is plugged in, your volume on your device needs to be on and turned up. If there is no sound check the Black Control Box.



Black Control Box:

This box is found usually in the back of the room.

1. Power is on, check for green light
2. Master volume control is up
3. MP3 volume control is up



To use Apple TV...

Check to make sure projector is ON

1. Turn on the Apple TV, using the remote
2. It is on when the light is lit up



3. Switch A/B Box from Doc Cam to Apple TV




4. Plug sound cord into the back of the HDMI Converter Box.
If you forget this, there will be no sound.
Make sure Sound Box is on.



Projecting from your iPad



Swipe from the bottom of iPad
to access the Control Panel
Tap AirPlay



Scroll to find your Apple TV
Slide Mirroring over



If it looks like this you are
Mirroring, slide Control Panel
down



When done swipe up for
Control Panel, slide Mirroring
off, tap iPad
